



## Club Records Conditions

These rules come into force on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2007

### 1. Eligibility

Only first claim swimmers with fully paid up membership of Gravesend & Northfleet Swimming Club may claim a Club Record.

### 2. Records

The following age groups will be recognised for club records:

#### 2.1 Age Group Records

Club Age Group records will be established and recognised for the following age groups:

8 years and under, 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years, 16 years, 17 years, 18 years.

For club age group record purposes age will be determined as "age on the day of the swim".

A swimmer may only claim for the age group record that applies to them on the day of the swim.

#### 2.2 Junior and Senior Records

Club Senior and Junior records will also be established and recognised.

##### 2.2.1 Senior Records

Senior Records can be established by any eligible swimmer of any age.

##### 2.2.2 Junior Records

Junior records can only be established by an eligible swimmer under the age of 17 years on the day of the swim.

#### 2.3 Short Course

Short Course records will be established for all age groups, Senior and Junior for the following strokes and distances:

Butterfly	25m, 50m, 100m, 200m.
Backstroke	25m, 50m, 100m, 200m.
Breaststroke	25m, 50m, 100m, 200m.
Freestyle	25m, 50m, 100m, 200m, 400m 800m, 1500m.
Individual Medley	100m, 200m, 400m

For a short course record to be established the swim must be performed in a pool of not less than 25m in length and not more than 50m in length.

Short Course Records may be set for a metric distance if the time is bettered in an imperial length pool over a distance greater than the record. e.g 100m/110 yards.

## **2.4 Long Course**

Long Course records will be established for all age groups, Senior and Junior for the following strokes and distances:

Butterfly	50m, 100m, 200m.
Backstroke	50m, 100m, 200m.
Breaststroke	50m, 100m, 200m.
Freestyle	50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m.
Individual Medley	200m, 400m.

For a Long Course record to be established the swim must be performed in a pool of not less than 50m in length.

Long Course Records may be set for a metric distance if the time is bettered in an imperial length pool over a distance greater than the record. e.g 100m/110 yards.

## **3 General Conditions**

- 3.1 The swim time must have been achieved in an event swum under ASA Law or higher Governing Body.
- 3.2 Other than in Club Championships, and when representing the Club at an inter-club gala, it is up to the swimmer to claim a club record.
  - 3.2.1 A Club record may be claimed in any event where representing/swimming under the name of Gravesend & Northfleet Swimming Club or whilst representing a higher body e.g. School, County, Region or Country or other representative team providing all other conditions are met.
  - 3.2.2 An official result sheet/card is required and should be given to the Club Secretary.
- 3.3 A record may be claimed in the first leg of a relay provided the Referee has agreed and has signed the results sheet.
- 3.4 Should you equal a Club record the Club record will be shared along with the existing record holder
- 3.5 The Executive Committee will verify all records and be the sole determinant of the application of Club Record Conditions.
- 3.6 Upon ratification the swimmer will receive an acknowledgement of the record

## **Club Championship Event Best Performances**

### **1. Eligibility**

Event Best Performances (EBP's) will be established and recognised for all club championship events and can only be established by a swimmer entered in that particular event in the Club Championships whilst swimming in that event.

### **2. Events, Age Groups and Distances**

Events and Age Groups will be determined by the Club Championship Programme designated by the Executive committee each year.

### **3. General Conditions**

- 3.1. The swim time must have been achieved in an event swum under ASA Law.
- 3.2. Should you equal an EBP the EBP will be shared along with the existing EBP holder.
- 3.3. The Executive Committee will verify all EBP's and be the sole determinant of the application of Club Championship Event Best Performance Conditions.
- 3.4. Upon ratification the swimmer will receive an acknowledgement of the record
